

The Henderson County Public Library District is temporarily closing effective at 5 pm, Wednesday, March 18th until further notice.

The Henderson County Public Library District and the Bookmobile will close temporarily, starting Wednesday, March 18 at 5 pm. This decision follows our monitoring of state and national health sites and the recommendation by the Illinois Library Association to close all libraries to the public for a period of time.

As of today, we plan to remain closed until further notice. We will continue to monitor the situation and reassess as more information becomes available.

In the meantime, any questions you can call the library at 309.627.2450 and leave a message. This might change, but at this moment of time, that is our plan.

We will stop charging fines, waive all existing overdue fines, and extend due dates on all currently checked out materials until May 1. Don't feel the need to return anything while we are closed. Just stay home and enjoy your family!
